If you are already a tutor, mentor, Undergraduate or Graduate and/or want to help young students in education achieve their best results in Maths, English Language, English Literature, Biology, Chemistry and/or Physics we would love to have you on our team.

We are looking for friendly, patient, hard-working, reliable and dedicated tutors to teach the Core Subjects using online web applications (provided by ED TREE). You would be joining a start-up team who are passionate about making a difference to each student. Applicants must have experience either tutoring, working as an educational mentor, working with children and/or young people and teaching at school. You must also hold at least an A-Level qualification in the relevant subjects (Maths, English and Science).

Criteria:

- Applicants must be either an Undergraduate or Graduate
- A relevant degree or equivalent qualification in the subject area(s) (preferred), candidates with other qualifications will be considered.
- Access to a computer, good WiFi and personal mobile phone (for communication)
- Experience teaching or tutoring students (7 to 16) and an understanding of challenges faced with online learning and safeguarding
- Knowledge of the curriculum
- Good ICT Skills
- Evidence of good interpersonal skills and time commitment
- Willingness to participate in training, learning new software and communication tools
- Proof of a "Right to work in the UK"

Tutors will be required to work from 3 pm to 8 pm on weekdays and 11 am to 5 pm on Saturdays. Tutors will be trained to use our third-party applications (such as the learning software and video conferencing), knowledge of IT is desired as ED TREE is an online learning service.

Applicants will be expected to attach a CV with two up-to-date references and a short cover letter explaining why they deem suitable for the job (using experiences encountered).

Successful applicants will be informed within 2 weeks of review, where an online interview will be conducted alongside a short mock exam. Applicants will also be given scenarios and a “mock tutor” session.

Qualifications must be scanned on request, as well as completion of an Enhanced DBS Check. Failure to comply with this at this stage will result in a termination of the process.

Pay rate: £10 per hour, higher rates will be for those who meet higher levels of experience.

Hours: All contracts are subject to successful DBS Checks. Tutors are paid for the hour they teach. This will be discussed on a case-by-case basis.
